Overview

Leaders are expected to be above reproach in their personal life, be committed to the ministry and be a team player. We expect that you will be regularly attending church, reading the Bible, part of a community group, and sharing your life with God in prayer.

What does this look like?

1. Personal Life

This is outlined in our document called “Above reproach” which outlines our expectations of leaders involved in kids and/or youth ministry at St. Luke’s.

2. Committed to Kids Church

This will mean that you:

- **Pray** for the children in your care and the ministry
- **Care for, encourage, and build** personal relationships with children in the group. (1 Thessalonians 2:8)
- Are **prepared** for kids church with the material provided to you via the google drive and are **punctual** and **enthusiastic**
- Attend leader **training** events and meetings provided at the start of the year
- **Lead** or **assist** teaching lessons during term
- **Communicate** unavailabilities through Elvanto before the start of each new term. And communicate directly with Mark during term if you are unavailable due to unforeseen circumstances (*ie. family emergency etc.*)

3. Compliance

- Current Safe Ministry Training (Essentials or Refresher for 18 year old and over volunteers, Junior Leaders Course for 13-17 year old’s)
- Current appropriate Safe Ministry Check Form
